A taxi from the Indianapolis airport will cost approximately \$25 to most of the downtown hotels.

Tournament Registration

Registration will occur inside the Maryland Street entrance, next to the main Gen Con event registration area, from 12:00 PM–6:00 PM on Thursday, August 14. Late registration will occur at the Continental Championship stage in Hall G from 7:45 AM–8:30 AM on Friday, August 15.

Players will have the opportunity to ask rules questions during registration. Rules questions *will not* be answered during the player meeting.

To register, each competitor must present one of the following forms of identification:

- a driver's license
- a passport
- a photocopy of his or her birth certificate **and** a photo ID (such as a military ID, a school ID, a bank card, etc.)

*UDE will provide each registered Continentals competitor with a 4-day badge to Gen Con Indy. You **must** have your Gen Con badge on your person at all times; failure to do so can result in being ejected from the convention by Gen Con security. If you lose your Gen Con badge, UDE cannot replace it.

Tournament Information

Format

Day 1 Format (Friday, August 15)

- **WoW TCG** Constructed format (See tournament policies at www.ude.com/op/policy.)
- Number of Swiss-style rounds will be determined based on attendance.

Day 2 Format (Saturday, August 16)

- **WoW TCG** Booster Draft
- One booster of *March of the Legion*, one booster of *Servants of the Betrayer* and one booster of *Hunt for Illidan* will be used for the drafts.
- Competition will consist of six Swiss-style rounds.

Day 3 Format–Top 8 (Sunday, August 17)

- **WoW TCG** Constructed format.
- Players will use the same Constructed decks they used during competition on Day 1.
- Each round will be single-elimination. The quarterfinals and semifinals will be best 2 games out of 3. The finals will be best 3 games out of 5.

Round Length

- Each round on Day 1 and Day 2 will be 60 minutes long.
- On Day 3, the quarterfinals and semifinals will each be 120 minutes long, and the finals will be 210 minutes long.

Advancement

- All qualified players may participate on Day 1 (Friday).
- Advancement to Day 2 will be determined based on record, and the number of players in Day 1.
- The Top 8 players after the Saturday Swiss rounds will advance to Day 3 (Sunday).

Sporting Conduct and Professionalism

- The promotion of sporting conduct and professionalism is a high priority at the WoW TCG Continental Championship.
- Participants in the WoW TCG Continental Championship are expected to behave in a mature, professional, and sporting manner at all times before, during, and after the tournament.
- Participants in the WoW TCG Continental Championship are expected to dress in an appropriate and professional manner.

Decklists and Other Forms

- Decklists for the Constructed portion of the event will be collected at the tables at 9:00 AM during the player meeting on Friday. Players should double-check their decklists before turning them in. Decklists must be complete and accurate when they are collected.

- The following sets are legal in the Constructed portion of this event: *Heroes of Azeroth* [HOA], Onyxia's Lair treasure pack, *Through the Dark Portal* [TDP], *The Burning Crusade* Collector's Edition promo cards, *Molten Core* Treasure Pack, *BlizzCon 2007* promo card, *Fires of Outland* [FOO], *Feast of Winter's Veil*, Magtheridon's Lair treasure pack, Crafted Redemption cards 1-14, *March of the Legion* [MOL], *Servants of the Betrayer* [SOTB] and *Hunt For Illidan* [HF1].
- Players must bring pens, paper, card sleeves, and appropriate counters with them to the tournament. Please note that the front of all card sleeves must be clear and have no designs. Card sleeves that feature any designs on the front will not be allowed in the WoW TCG Continental Championship. Card sleeves with

designs on the back can be used in the event. Players should always be careful to make sure that sleeves are not marked in any way.

Invitation Information

A player may qualify for the WoW Continental Championship through one of the following methods:

- Finished in the Top 8 of a Darkmoon Faire Championship between August 18, 2007 and August 11, 2008.
- Finished in the Top 2 of a Regional Qualifier between August 18, 2007 and August 11, 2008.
- Yearly Honor Ranking is greater than or equal to 4.
- Lifetime Honor Ranking is greater than or equal to 7.
- Constructed Rating is greater than or equal to 2850.
- Limited Rating greater than or equal to 2750.
